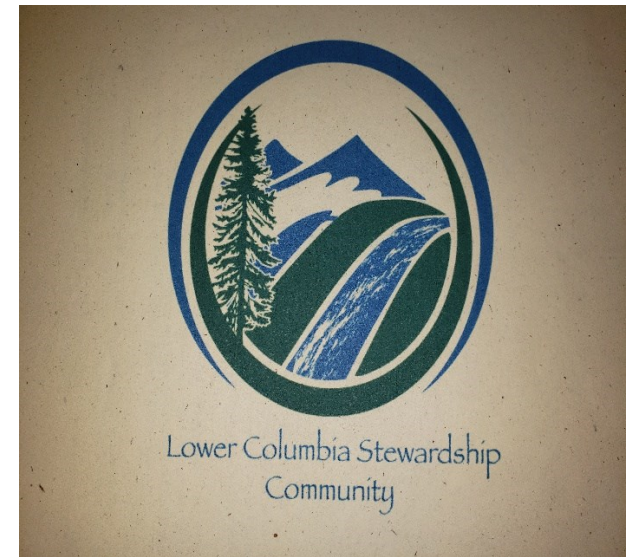

Did You Know

Pacific Coast Fertilizer (PCF)

A proposed anhydrous ammonia chemical plant for the Mint Farm in Longview, is hazardous to surrounding areas and the air pollution resulting from the manufacturing process and the proximity to residential areas. This should have precluded this project a long time ago. Longview residents are encouraged to keep an eye on this project.

Millennium Bulk Terminals

The proposed coal project in Longview of 44 million metric tons of coal MLB wants to add to our area yields about 90 million metric tons of carbon dioxide when used. It would also bring 2 ½ hours of increased traffic delays due to the 16 trains a day needed to transport the coal

No Methanol Refinery, No NWIW

If built, this refinery in Kalama would become the top polluter of WA and use as much fracked gas as 1/3 of the entire state. This project would use more than all other industrial companies in Washington COMBINED. It would emit over 1 million tons of GHG from the flare stack alone and up to 7 million tons when including "upstream" methane leakage from extraction and pipelines. We know better.
